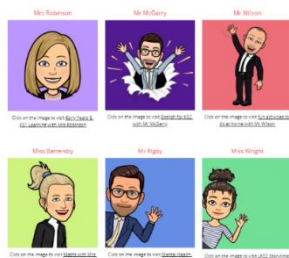
Home Learning Website
