

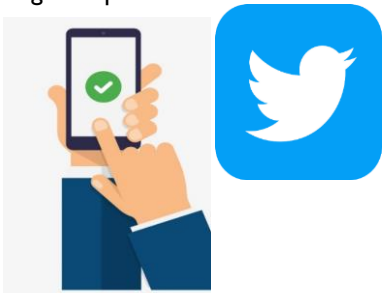

In Y3, they had a visit from the RSPCA to learn about how to be a responsible citizen whilst looking after pets and local wildlife.
