## UP COMING DATES

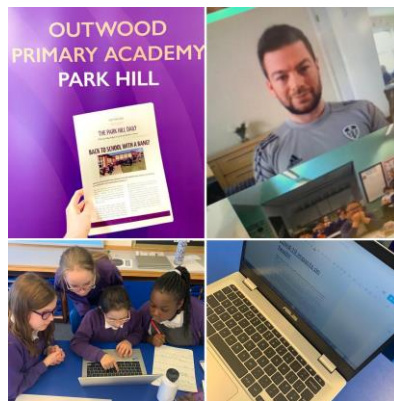
More information to follow for events throughout the summer term.
