Our amazing staff team have been working so hard over the summer to make the classroom environments look outstanding ready for the start of the new academic year.



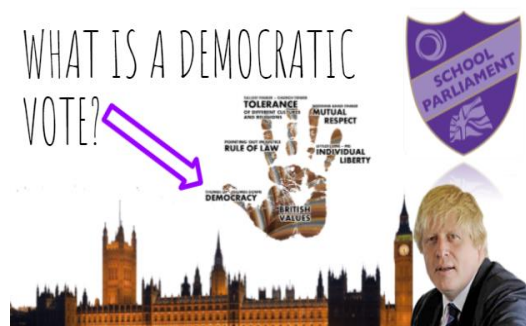
Healthy Harvest FOOD BANK
